Confessing our Faith — Westminster Shorter Catechism¹

Leader: What happened to man in the fall?

People: **Man fell into a condition of sin and misery.**

Leader: What is sinful about man's fallen condition?

People: **The sinfulness of that fallen condition is twofold. First, in what is commonly called original sin, there is the guilt of Adam's first sin with its lack of original righteousness and the corruption of his whole nature. Second are all the specific acts of disobedience that come from original sin.**

¹ Questions 17-19. The WSC was published in 1646 by the Westminster Divines as a teaching tool on the Bible and Theology, particularly in the wake of the Protestant Reformation.

Leader: What is the misery of man's fallen condition?

People: **By their fall all mankind lost fellowship with God and brought His anger and curse on themselves. They are therefore subject to all the miseries of this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell forever.**
