Praise

Call to Worship – adapted from 1 John 1:5, Psalm 27:1

Leader: This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

People: **The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?**

Prayer of Adoration

*Leader:*¹ Our Father, who art in heaven hallowed be thy name.

People: **Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.**

Our God's Alive

Confessing our Faith — Apostle's Creed²

Christian, what do you Believe?

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, the Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, whence He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic³ church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Renewal

Prayers of the People

Leader: Let us bring our needs before God.

People: **Give us this day our daily bread.**

Confession of Sin – adapted from Ecclesiastes 12, 1 John 1, Psalm 36

Leader: Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.

People: **If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.**

Leader: Transgression speaks to the wicked deep in his heart; there is no fear of God before his eyes. For he flatters himself in his own eyes that his iniquity cannot be found out and hated. The words of his mouth are trouble and deceit; he has ceased to act wisely and do good.

People: **If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.**

People: He plots trouble while on his bed; he sets himself in a way that is not good; he does not reject evil.

All: **Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.**

Silent confession

Assurance of Pardon – adapted from 1 John 1, Psalm 36

Leader: If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

People: **How precious is your steadfast love, O God!**

Leader: The children of mankind take refuge in the shadow of your wings. They feast on the abundance of your house, and you give them drink from the river of your delights.

People: **We feast and we drink at your table! For with you is the fountain of life; in your light do we see light.**

Again (1 Kings 18:36-37)

Commitment

Leader: Sanctify us in the truth. Your word is truth.

People: **Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever, amen.**
