Call to Worship – adapted from Psalm 119:129-131

Leader: Your testimonies are wonderful; therefore my soul keeps them. The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.

Confessing our Faith — Apostle's Creed²

Christian, what do you Believe?

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, the Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. People: **My eyes shed streams of tears, because people do not keep your law.**

All: **Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.**

Silent confession

Assurance of Pardon – adapted from Jeremiah 31:33-34

Leader: For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people... For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

People: **Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever, amen.**
