Praise

Call to Worship – adapted from Psalm 28:8-9

Leader: The Lord is the strength of his people; he is the saving refuge of his anointed.

People: **Oh, save your people and bless your heritage! Be their shepherd and carry them forever.**

Prayer of Adoration

*Leader:*¹ Our Father, who art in heaven hallowed be thy name.

People: **Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.**

Confessing our Faith — Apostle's Creed²

Christian, what do you Believe?

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, the Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. Prayers of the People

Leader: Let us bring our needs before God.

People: **Give us this day our daily bread.**

Confession of Sin – adapted from Psalm 28:1-3

Leader: Lord, hear our prayer.

All: **Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.**

Leader: To you, O Lord, I call; my rock, be not deaf to me, lest, if you be silent to me, I become like those who go down to the pit.

People: **Hear the voice of my pleas for mercy, when I cry to you for help, when I lift up my hands toward your most holy sanctuary. Do not drag me off with the wicked, with the workers of evil, who speak peace with their neighbors while evil is in their hearts.**

Assurance of Pardon – adapted from Psalm 28:6-7

Leader: Blessed be the Lord! For he has heard the voice of my pleas for mercy.

People: **The Lord is my strength and my shield; in him my heart trusts, and I am helped; my heart exults, and with my song I give thanks to him.**
