Call to Worship – adapted from Psalm 100

Leader: Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth! Serve the Lord with gladness!
Come into his presence with singing!

People: **We raise our song as an offering!**

Leader: Know that the Lord, he is God!

People: **It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.**

Leader: Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name!

People: **For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.**

Prayer of Adoration

*Leader:*¹ Our Father, who art in heaven hallowed be thy name.

People: **Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.**

Confessing our Faith — Apostle's Creed²

Confession of Sin – adapted from Revelation 2:1-5

To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: ‘The words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks among the seven golden lampstands

Leader: ‘I know your works, your toil and your patient endurance, and how you cannot bear with those who are evil, but have tested those who call themselves apostles and are not, and found them to be false. I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name’s sake, and you have not grown weary. But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. 5 Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first.

All: **Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.**
