People: **Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.**

Confessing our Faith — Apostle's Creed²

Christian, what do you Believe?

**I believe in God, the Father Almighty, the Creator of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord: Who was conceived of the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was

ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, whence
He shall come to judge the living and the dead.**

Confession of Sin – adapted from Psalm 101:2

Leader: I will ponder the way that is blameless. Oh when will you come to me?

All: **Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.**

Silent confession

Assurance of Pardon – adapted from Psalm 101:2-4

Leader: Because you have pardoned our guilt and called us to follow you:
