Confessing our Faith — Heidelberg Catechism²

Leader: What is your only comfort in life and in death?

People: That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ.

He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.

Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.

Prayers of the People

Leader: Let us bring our needs before God.

People: Give us this day our daily bread.

Confession of Sin – adapted from Psalm 96:7–10

Leader: Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength! Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering, and come into his courts!

People: Worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness; tremble before him, all the earth!

Leader: Say among the nations, “The Lord reigns! Yes, the world is established; it shall never be moved; he will judge the peoples with equity.”

People: Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.

Silent confession

Assurance of Pardon – adapted from Psalm 96:11–13

Leader: Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice; let the sea roar, and all that fills it;

People: let the field exult, and everything in it!

Leader: Then shall all the trees of the forest sing for joy before the Lord, for he comes, for he comes to judge the earth.

People: He will judge the world in righteousness, and the peoples in his faithfulness.

***Resurrecting**

Leader: I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?"


