Prayers of the People

Leader: Let us bring our needs before God.

Confession of Sin – adapted from Psalm 90:3–13

Leader: You return man to dust and say, “Return, O children of man!” For a thousand years in your sight are but as yesterday when it is past, or as a watch in the night. You sweep them away as with a flood; they are like a dream, like grass that is renewed in the morning: in the morning it flourishes and is renewed; in the evening it fades and withers.

People: **For we are brought to an end by your anger; by your wrath we are dismayed. You have set our iniquities before you, our secret sins in the light of your presence.**

Leader: For all our days pass away under your wrath; we bring our years to an end like a sigh.

People: **Make us glad for as many days as you have afflicted us, and for as many years as we have seen evil.**

Leader: Let your work be shown to your servants, and your glorious power to their children.

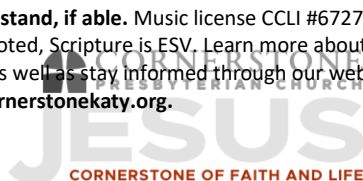
