Silent Confession

Assurance of Pardon – adapted from Psalm 40:16–17

Leader: But may all who seek you rejoice and be glad in you;

People: **may those who love your salvation say continually, “Great is the Lord!”**

Leader: As for me, I am poor and needy, but the Lord takes thought for me.

People: **You are my help and my deliverer; do not delay, O my God!**
